Civic Community Archiving with the Platform for Experimental Collaborative Ethnography (PECE)

This workshop will offer hands-on opportunities to use the Platform for Experimental Collaborative Ethnography (PECE), a digital workspace built for anthropologists and the communities they work with. I will give a brief overview of existing PECE instances, platform design logics, and ongoing projects. Participants will then have the chance to try features of the platform and explore potential use for their own projects. Attendees should bring a laptop and any materials (such as images, photos, memos, or analytic questions) they are comfortable sharing, as we collectively explore PECE's possibilities. All research materials can be kept private and removed after the trial run. The workshop will close with an round of feedback that can inform future design of PECE.
